### **Tasks**

#### **Workshop duties**

- Check and refurbish hydraulic power packs and fluid control equipment including cylinder repairs and reseals and hose preparation
- Reseal hydraulic cylinders
- Inspect drives, motors, check fluid levels, replace filters, or perform other maintenance actions, following checklists.
- Repair or replace defective equipment parts, using hand tools and power tools, and reassemble equipment
- Fabricate and make replacement parts as required
- Strip and disassemble machinery
- Fabricate and weld hoppers, guarding and hydraulic lift assemblies
- Check and refurbish associated electrical control panels and other circuits
- Reassemble and test all refurbished equipment
- Receive and despatch parts
- Ability to read engineering drawings
- Assemble, install or repair wiring
- Complete condition reports and necessary worksheets

## **Skills**

- Hydraulic circuits and mechanical experience is essential
- Knowledge of machines and tools, including their designs, uses, repair, and maintenance would be an advantage
- Electrical experience and an understanding of electrical circuits and electronic/electrical enclosures.
- Welding and fabrication skills
